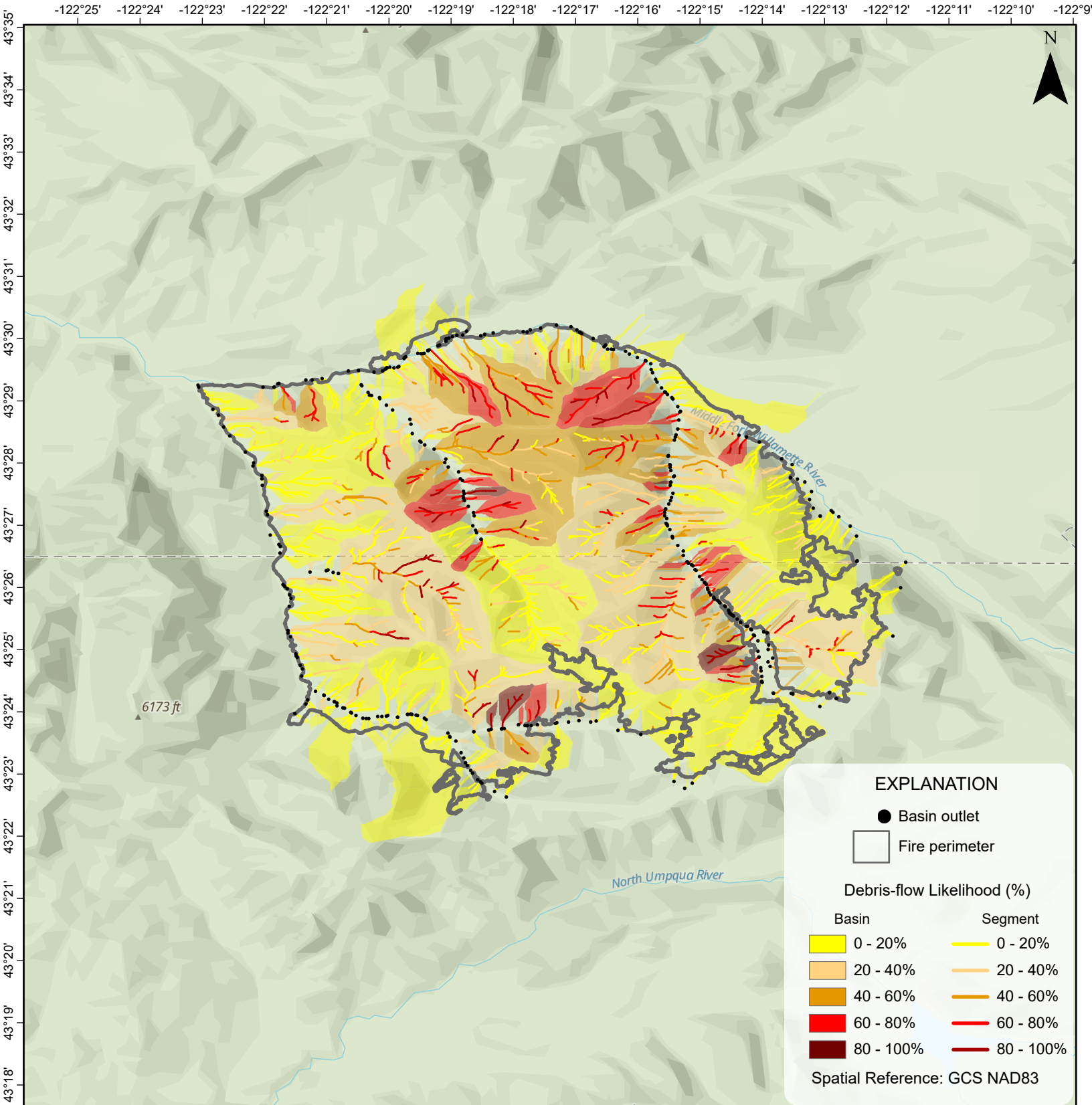


Emigrant Creek Fire, Umpqua National Forest
