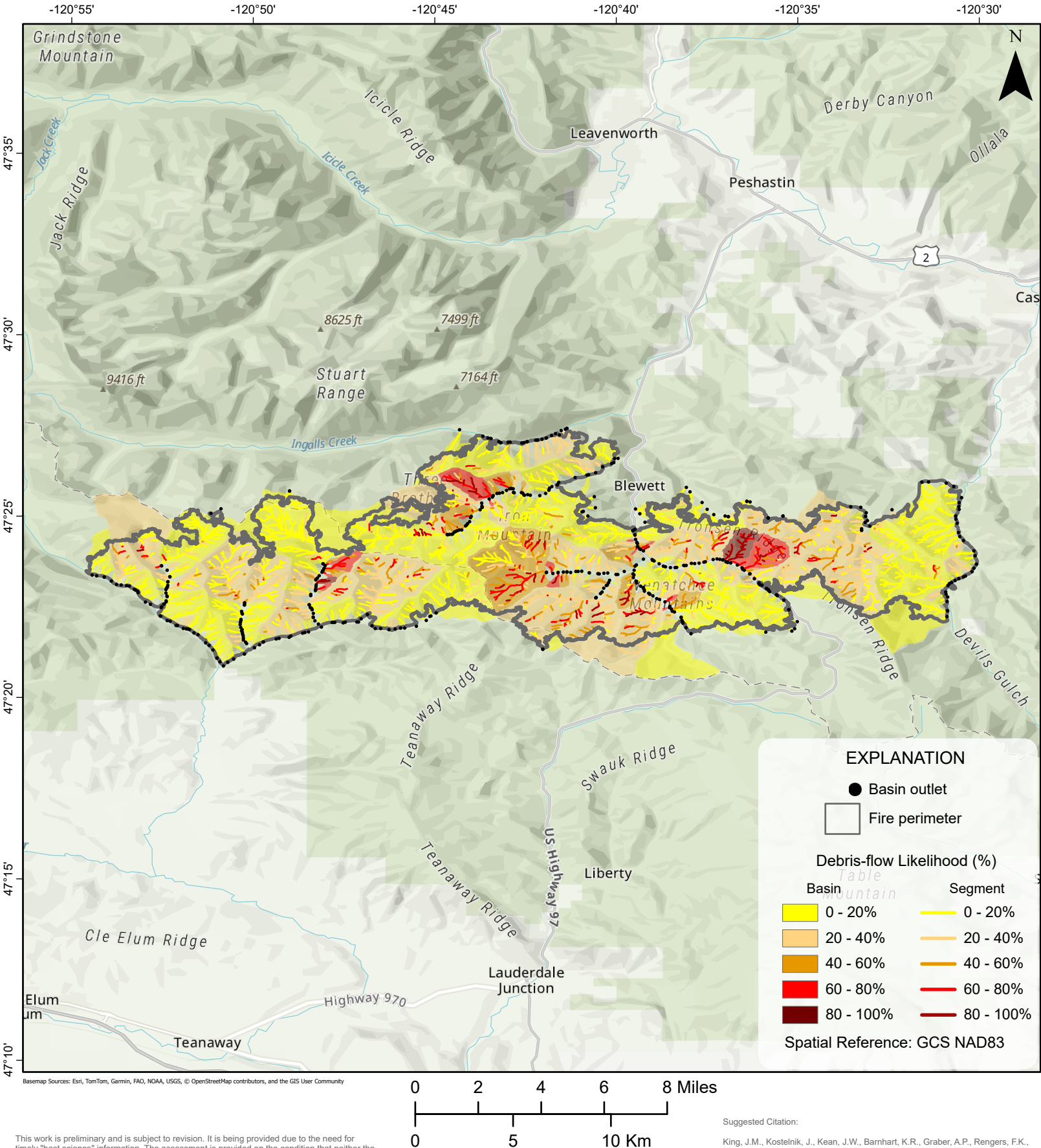


Labor Mountain Fire, Okanogan-Wenatchee National Forest
